Map Middle East 2007: The Largest Geospatial Middle East Geospatial Forum

7 March 2007, NOIDA, India: The third Map Middle East conference is scheduled to be held in Dubai International Convention and Exhibition Centre, Dubai, UAE from 9 - 11 April, 2007. Jointly organised by Dubai Municipality and GIS Development, the conference is being sponsored by Digital Globe, ESRI and Intergraph as Platinum Sponsors, Trimble and Bentley as Gold Sponsors and Global Scan, Leica Geosystems Geospatial Imaging, Map Info, IIC Technologies, Tele Atlas Maps and Topcon as Silver Sponsors.

Also a part of the conference would be a Round Table Discussion on Spatial Data Infrastructure (SDI). A

great development has been recorded, particularly in the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) countries. This

discussion forum on Spatial Data Infrastructure will review the status of SDI activities within the various

organizations using Geo-information on local and national levels.

This year's conference will also witness four seminars as a part of Map Middle East 2007. The topics that are

considered are in respect to the ongoing development and progress in different vertical segments like

Construction & Engineering, Oil & Gas, Critical Infrastructure Protection and Emergency Management and

Open Source Geospatial.

The 2nd GIS Educational Forum is being organized by Dubai Municipality in collaboration with Ministry of

Education, Ministry of Social Affairs and Zayed Center for Children of Spatial Needs from 10-11 April, 2007

under the umbrella of Map Middle East 2007. The forum aims at spreading awareness and setting up a sound

foundation of geospatial science and technologies by educating future generations. The forum will address the

awareness and the need for GIS among the students and how it is going to help them in day to day life. It is

being sponsored by Pictometry Middle East.
