



## Google Earth CTO at Map World Forum

21 December 2006, New Delhi, India: Michael Jones, Chief Technology Officer, Google Earth has consented to speak at the Plenary Session on 'Geospatial Information: Emerging Business Models' at *Map World Forum*. The session will focus on the 'Charge vs. No Charge' issue for geospatial data, which is utilized by a large number of infrastructures, utility, natural resource management and business intelligence projects. Michael Jones works, on the Earth browser software, we now know as *Google Earth* has created a paradigm shift in the industry in this regard.

The other prominent personalities addressing this session along with Michael Jones will be Member of the Department of Geography, University of Durham, **Emeritus Prof. Michael Blakemore** and Member of Parliament, Government of India, **Mr. Suresh Prabhu**.

In addition, Michael Jones will also be addressing the Seminar on 'Standards and Interoperability' during the conference as a Keynote Speaker. The seminar is being coordinated by Open Geospatial Consortium (OGC) and Chaired by **Mark Reichardt**, President, OGC. The seminar will offer a foundation for dissemination of knowledge about OGC's framework of open standards for web and location based services. There would be a preview of upcoming standards as well as an overview on how geospatial standards fit into the broader Information Technology standards.
